

Lash Lift and Brow Lamination Evaluation

Client Consultation:

- Greet client and escort to work area.
- Assess the client's current style.
- Determine the client's preferences.
- Assess client's needs.
- Assess client's skin by performing a skin analysis to ensure that there is no inflamed, infected, broken, raised, or swollen skin in the area to be worked on; or an open wound or sore in the area to be worked on, infection, or infestation (i.e. lice) to prevent from safely performing service.
- Assess client's consultation form for any medications and products used within the last 72 hours. Consult on any known allergies.
- Consult with client on any facial surgeries within the last 3 months and if client under physicians' care.
- Assess if the client is prone to cold sores or fever blisters.
- Assess if the client has used exfoliating or lightening agents with in the last 72 hours. (AHA's, BHA's, hydroquinone, etc.)
- Assess facial injections within the last 3 weeks. (Botox, or Hyaluronic fillers)
- If client is free from the above move forward with procedure.

Wash Hands Procedure:

- Wet hands with running water.
- Apply liquid soap.
- Wash palms to the end of wrist, back of hands to the end of the wrist, each finger, and thumb.
- Wash both hands while interlocking fingers.
- Rinse thoroughly with running water.
- Dry with a clean towel or disposable towel.

Tools/Supply Set up:

- Gloves
- Headband/hairnet
- Cotton Swabs
- Cotton pad
- Tissue
- Disposable Applicator Sticks
- Disposable Portion Cups/Dish
- Disposable mascara wand
- Lash Perming Roller or Pad

Products needed:

- Eye makeup remover
- Lash or Brow Adhesive
- Lash or Brow Waving Solution
- Neutralizing Lotion
- Water

Equipment needed:

- Equipment cart
- Magnifying lamp
- Facial bed or chair

Preparation:

- Disinfect work station, bed and equipment using a disinfectant wipe (following manufacturer's instructions)
- Check equipment to ensure all devices are in safe working order and plugged in to a working receptacle.
- Dispense products needed for the service.
 - Prepare disposable portion cups for each product with a portion of product by opening the top of the container and ensuring the tip of the nozzle does not come into contact with the disposable portion cup/tray or remove product with a disinfected or clean single use spatula. Close the lid to the product and set the portion cup/tray on the tray.
- Drape Facial Bed using 1 fitted sheet, 1 flat sheet and 3 towels.
 - Place clean, laundered sheets down on disinfected facial bed, placing a towel horizontally at the head of the bed.
 - Lay a hair net and head band on top of the first towel, along with a rolled towel to support the head and neck of the client.
 - Save the 3rd towel to lay across the client décolleté.
- Or use disposable table paper to drape the bed.

Client Preparation:

- Help client onto the bed.
- Place the hair net and head band on the client's head to cover the hair and ears completely.
- Place the rolled towel under the client's neck to support the head of the client.

Washing hands Procedure:

- Wet hands with running water.
- Apply liquid soap.
- Lather and rub palms to the end of wrist, back of hands to the end of the wrist, each finger, and thumb for 20 seconds.
- Rub both hands while interlocking fingers.

- Rinse thoroughly with running water.
- Dry with a clean towel or disposable towel.

Service Performance:

- Identify perming products to be used and reads manufacturer's instructions for mixing and usage.
- Determine the size of the roller size desired for the amount of lift to be achieved if applicable.
- Apply gloves.
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Prepare Brows and Lashes: (to remove makeup, natural oils, and debris)

- Apply cleansing product to eye brows and lashes
 - Retrieve cleansing product from disposable portion cup/tray with a disposable spatula and apply to 2X2/pads or cotton rounds with eye makeup remover.
 - Place the eye pads on the client's closed eyes
 - Use a 2x2 or 4x4 moistened with a makeup remover to remove brow color.
 - Hold the opposite side of the brow, with the thumb of your free hand apply firm pressure and remove brow color from the outer corner to the inside.
 - Pat dry.
 - Repeat the step on the other brow.
 - Double brace while wiping the eye area working in a downward sweeping motion to clean lashes and lids, with 3 passes. Clean under eye area from outside corner to inside with 3 passes for each eye. Take caution not to pull or tug on the eyes.
 - Repeat if necessary.
 - Allow to dry for 2 minutes.
 - Discard disposable cotton pad in waste receptacle.
- Application of Protective Cream or petroleum jelly
 - With gloved hands, dispense protective cream or petroleum jelly by opening the top of the container and ensuring no contamination of the container. Using a spatula dispense a small amount of product into product cup, close the top of the container. Place the used spatula into your 'to be disinfected' container.
 - **INSTRUCT CLIENT TO KEEP EYES CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.**
- Ensure lashes and brow are entirely dry before proceeding.

Lash Lifting

- Carefully place a damp cotton pad on the lower lid on top of the protective cream to prevent fumes from entering the eyes and protect the skin from the product.
- Bend the roller slightly to conform to the shape of the eye.
- Gently place the perming roller or pad to the top of the base of the upper lashes.
- Carefully use the disposable applicator to press each lash against the roller or pad, ensuring no overlapping and that each is secured against the roller or pad.

- Discard applicator in waste receptacle.
- Verify that none of the lower lashes are on the pad
- Carefully apply the perming solution to the lashes that are securely adhered to the roller or rod, avoiding the skin and following manufacturer's directions.
 - Dip cotton swab or brush applicator into the waving solution.
 - Remove excess from the cotton swab or brush applicator.
 - Carefully apply waving solution to the lashes in an upward motion until lashes are evenly coated. Ensure not to get product in the clients, eyes, nose or mouth.
- Process according to manufacturer's directions.
- Remove waving solution with a wet cotton pad without dripping water in the client's eyes.
 - Moving in an upward motion, with a light hand remove waving solution.
 - Repeat at least 3 times, to remove all waving solution for the lash area.
 - Discard used cotton pads in waste receptacle.
- Remove used under-eye pads and discard in waste receptacle and replace with new eye pads if need.
- Carefully apply the neutralizing solution to the lashes that are securely adhered to the roller or rod, avoiding the skin and following manufacturer's direction.
 - Dip cotton swab or brush applicator into the neutralizing solution.
 - Remove excess from the cotton swab or brush applicator.
 - Carefully apply neutralizing solution to the lashes in an upward motion until lashes are evenly coated. Ensure not to get product in the clients, eyes, nose or mouth.
- Process according to manufacturer's directions.
- Remove neutralizing solution with a wet cotton pad without dripping water in the client's eyes.
 - Moving in an upward motion, with a light hand remove neutralizing solution.
 - Repeat at least 3 times, to remove all waving solution for the lash area.
 - Discard used cotton pads in waste receptacle.
- Slowly roll the lashes off of the rod or pad.
- Remove protective eye pad from underneath the eyes.
- Discard protective eye pad in waste receptacle.
- Use a cotton pad moistened with the makeup remover or cleanser to cleanse the eye area
 - Wipe the eye area working in a downward sweeping motion to clean lashes and lids, with 3 passes. Clean under eye area from outside corner to inside with 3 passes for each eye. Take caution not to pull or tug on the eyes. Repeat if necessary.
 - Discard cotton pad in waste receptacle.

Brow Lamination

- Carefully place a cotton pad below each brow on top of the protective cream to protect the skin from the product and catch any excess solution.
- Gently use the mascara wand to comb the brows up into the desired shape and pattern.
- Carefully apply the lash or brow adhesive using an applicator as recommended by the manufacturer to better ensure the final appearance of the brows.
- Discard applicator in waste receptacle.
- Carefully apply the perming solution to the brow avoiding the skin and following manufacturer's direction.
 - Dip cotton swab or brush applicator into the waving solution.
 - Remove excess from the cotton swab or brush applicator.
 - Carefully apply waving solution to the brows in an upward motion until brows are evenly coated. Ensure not to get product in the clients, eyes, nose or mouth.
- Process according to manufacturer's directions.
- Remove waving solution with a wet cotton pad without dripping water in the client's eyes.
 - Moving in an upward motion, with a light hand remove waving solution.
 - Repeat at least 3 times, to remove all waving solution for the brow area.
 - Discard used cotton pads in waste receptacle.
- Remove used under-eye pads and discard in waste receptacle and replace with new eye pads if need.
- Carefully apply the neutralizing solution to the brow avoiding the skin and following manufacturer's direction.
 - Dip cotton swab or brush applicator into the neutralizing solution.
 - Remove excess from the cotton swab or brush applicator.
 - Carefully apply neutralizing solution to the brows in an upward motion until brows are evenly coated. Ensure not to get product in the clients, eyes, nose or mouth.
- Process according to manufacturer's directions.
- Remove neutralizing solution with a wet cotton pad without dripping water in the client's eyes.
 - Moving in an upward motion, with a light hand remove neutralizing solution.
 - Repeat at least 3 times, to remove all waving solution for the lash area.
 - Discard used cotton pads in waste receptacle.
- Remove protective eye pad from underneath the eyes.
- Discard protective eye pad in waste receptacle.
- Use a cotton pad moistened with the makeup remover or cleanser to cleanse the eye area
 - Wipe the brow area working in an upward sweeping motion to clean brow and lids, with 3 passes. Take caution not to pull or tug on the eyes. Repeat if necessary.
 - Discard cotton pad in waste receptacle.

Post Service:

- Client follow up: Discuss maintenance and after care.
- Single use items are discarded.
- Place implements in a closed container labeled "To Be Disinfected".
- Place cape and used towels into closed container until laundered.

Work area cleaned and disinfected:

- Identify proper cleaning agent and reads manufacturer's directions.
- Follow manufacturer's directions for mixing/usage
- Wipe work station/area with cleaning solution, to remove debris.
- Identify disinfectant that is bactericidal, viricidal and fungicidal; EPA approved for use in salon setting.
- Follow manufacturer's directions for mixing and/or using appropriate aerosol disinfectant.
- Disinfect electrical equipment stored in clean area separate from other implements.

Remove gloves.

Wash hands.

A score must be achieved that is set by the schools grading standards to pass this evaluation plan.
