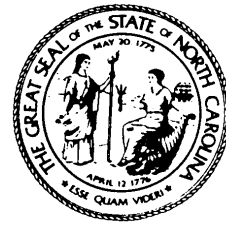

Employee Misclassification

Employee misclassification is defined as avoiding tax liabilities and other obligations imposed by Chapter 95, 96, 97, 105, or 143 of the North Carolina General Statutes by misclassifying an employee as an independent contractor. [N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-762(5)] When submitting your application for license or renewal, you are required by law to certify either statement before you can apply or renew:

- I certify that I have read and understood the Public Notice Statement above and have been investigated for employee misclassification. I acknowledge that I am required to send the results of the investigation to the North Carolina Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners (NCBCAE).
